HARRIS DEFENDS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Joe Harris, playing off a one handicap, successfully defended the Club Championship with rounds of 71 and 74 resulting in a 5 over par hole total. With the wind swirling on day one and the greens looking and rolling the finest they have in years, scoring on day one was superb.
