ENGLISH GOLF UNION HANDICAP RULE FOR 2010

For golfers across the country the English Golf Union have informed all clubs that any members wishing to enter club events MUST have an ACTIVE handicap. For this you must have posted three cards from January 1st – December 31st 2009.

Any members having entered less than three are required to post three qualifying scores to regain their active handicap. This is purely for entry to both home and away events, however an **INACTIVE** handicap can still be used for social golf.
